Training & Mentoring Unlocking Potential



WHAT IS THE TRAINING AND MENTORING PROGRAMME?

A Project based at 'Vision 21' designed to offer accredited courses and learning opportunities for adults with learning difficulties.

- All courses are accredited by WJEC.
- All tutors are experienced and qualified teachers.
- Course length range between 1 day and 1 years study.

- Courses cater for a range of abilities.
- Variety of subjects from basic life skills to work skills.
- Support in progression after courses such as placement within Vision 21 projects or registration with 'Quest' employment agency.
- Partnership with 'Quest' Employment Agency.



COURSES:

'Getting Ready for Work' 12 week course

Entry Level Certificate WJEC

A course designed for 'work-ready' individuals, preparing them for employment. This course is quite intense and offers a direct move-on to a placement with 'Quest' Employment Agency.



'Life Skills' 6 week course

Entry Level Certificate WJEC

A course focusing on basic life skills. This course is designed for individuals who need more support with social skills, dealing with people and understanding the world around them.



'Personal and Social Skills' 6 week course

Entry Level Certificate WJEC

A course focusing on skills for life and work. This course is designed for individuals who may need extra support in social skills, but are able to start learning about basic independence.
